

## Star 2 2011

This six pointed Celtic Star or Snowflake is tatted with three shuttles (two CTM and one with the ball thread CTM).

### Center

Begin with the two shuttles CTM

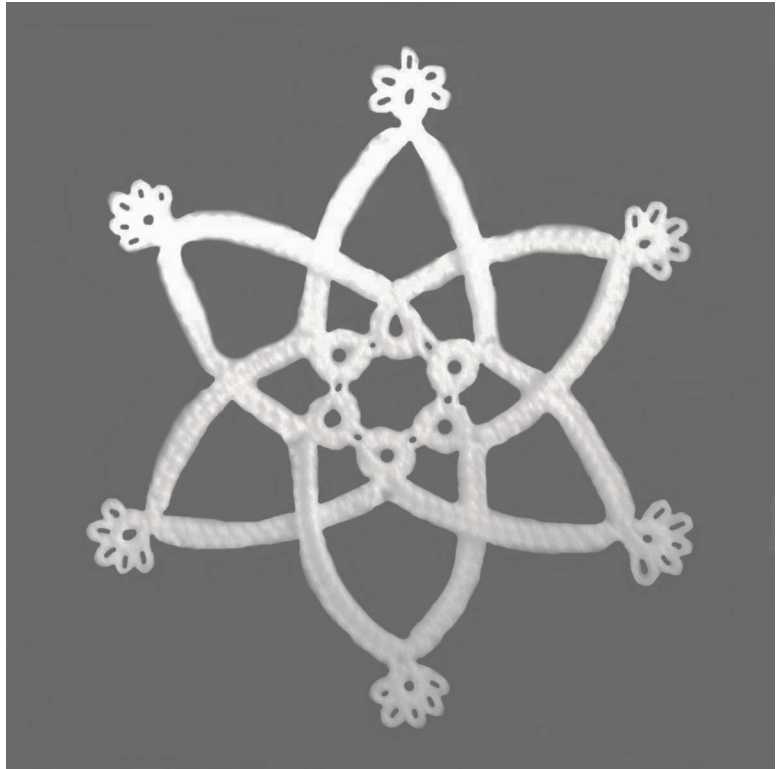
First Ring 3 - 3 - 3

Next Four Split Rings 3 - 3 / 3

Sixth Center Split Ring

Use the other shuttle to start this Split Ring to climb out of the round. 3 + 3 / 3

This join is to the first ring.



### Outside Round

(TWO SHUTTLES *from the center round*) Chain 15 BDS turn

Ring 2 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 2 turn (*all the rings at the points are the same*)

Tat one second half ds pulled pretty tight, then Chain 15 BDS + 15 BDS

This join skips one of the center rings and joins to the second from where this round started. *The 2<sup>nd</sup> half ds makes the point look better.*

With the BALL AND SHUTTLE CTM, make a picot to begin the chain by tying an overhand knot in the thread between the ball and shuttle and tat the first BDS a picot's distance from the knot. Continue with the BDS Chain so that there are 15 BDS total in this section of the chain. Now join to the picot of the center ring that was skipped, and tat 15 more BDS. Continue tating as shown in the photo. Weave the BDS Chains over and under as in the photo, alternating working with the pair of shuttles and the ball and shuttle.

Tie, hide, cut the two shuttle threads at the beginning of the outside round. Tie the ball and shuttle thread to the picot at the beginning of the ball and shuttle chain. Tat the final ring for the sixth point of the star.

This may be a simple Ring 2 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 2

or a Split Ring 2 - 1 - 1 / 2 - 1 - 1 Then tie the ends and make a loop for hanging.
